### 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Promotion

The end of the school year is fast approaching, and with it comes 8th grade promotion. The date for promotion is Thursday, May 20. The ceremony will begin at 10:00 am in the high school football stadium. Each student will be allowed to invite four guests to the ceremony and a ticket system will be used.
